3.	Students suggested that they should be imparted training on facing Job	Mock Interview Sessions were conducted by almost all the departments in coordination with college management.

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
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

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7. Apart from regular teaching, Social awareness and human values are to be imparted to students.


Employer Feedback Action Taken Report 2022 -23


The college has taken sets to increase the participation of alumni in college activities and events.

1. The Alumni Association of the College prepared an action plan to conduct lectures other than the syllabus to cover recent trends in the Industry.


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



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
2. The Association decided to carry out extra experiments for the courses during laboratory hours and plan more industry visits.
